## INTRODUCTION

This document details changes made to TemplaCMS and features added this month as an update release following the formal release of version 6.1.0.

All menu paths provided are based on the standard UK menu structure, as such certain options may be found in different locations where the menu navigator has been altered by the client.

# **Training**

**Note:** Where new functionality has been introduced, it is imperative that a full understanding of the implications for set-up and use are resolved by the client.

In some instances, where the new functionality is minimal, the TEAM Software Customer Success Manager can cover this with the client. However, where the functionality is not minimal or has implications elsewhere in the system, training must be provided by the TEAM Software implementation team to the client, a note to this effect will be added to the relevant sections.

#### **F**RAMEWORK

The TemplaCMS application and services run within the Microsoft .Net framework.

As a part of this update, the target version of the framework has been changed to 4.8 – a version which currently has no support end date.

Many servers and PCs already have this version (or a later version) of the framework installed, but if not, the following message displays when attempting to run the application:



This application requires one of the following versions of the .NET Framework:

.NETFramework, Version=v4.8

Do you want to install this .NET Framework version now?

The framework can be downloaded from the below URL:

Note that installation of the framework requires a reboot of the server or PC.

#### INTERCOMPANY REBATES

# **Background**

Previously, contract billing lines and invoice lines could not be defined as both Intercompany and Rebate. This restriction has been removed to allow this combination, where the rebate values are posted to the source accounts system and the net of rebate values are posted to the intercompany target accounts system.


## **Contract Billing**


On a Standard contract billing line (i.e. not Workbill, Recharge or Ad hoc), a combination of **Rebate** % and **Intercompany Site** is now permitted.

#### **Invoice Generation**

When generating invoice lines from a standard contract billing line that has a rebate percentage, the system creates two invoice lines, one for the contract billing line value less the rebate, and the second for the rebate value. When the source billing line has an Intercompany site, this is applied to the first line, but not to the rebate line.

For example, this contract billing line would result in the two invoice lines on the next page:






Note that it is not possible to select the **Intercompany** option on the second (rebate) line. If either of this pair of lines is amended, then a warning is issued to inform the user that the other line may need to be amended as well, as this is not automatic.

#### **Ad Hoc Invoices**

When entering ad-hoc invoices or credits, it is now possible to select both the **Intercompany** and the **Rebate** options on the same line, thus permitting entry of the appropriate details for both. On acceptance of such an item, the two invoice items are created as an Invoice Generation, with an Intercompany line and a non-Intercompany Rebate line.



#### **Invoice Post**

On posting an Intercompany invoice, the Intercompany Journal that is created is for the net of rebate value (in the above example, that would be £2424.00).

#### WORKBILL ONLY CONTRACTS

# **Background**

A requirement was presented for a simplified type of contract where no pay-related details are required or permitted. These contracts are intended exclusively for use with one-off Workbills.


## **Contract Type**

A new Workbills only option has been added to the Contract Type drop-down list within the Contract form.

When selected, the following tabs are hidden from the Contract form:

- Task pay (where available)
- Calendar
- Budget roster (where available)
- Budgets
- Pay
- Stores
- HS
- QA

A contract can only be changed to Workbills only if none of the above listed tabs contain data.



## **Task Wizard Behaviour**

When adding a new task to a **Workbills only** contract, the Task Wizard is automatically adjusted to reflect the reduced set of available options. This ensures consistency across both contract setup and task configuration.




## TIMEGATE+ INTERFACE - BREAK DETAILS


# **Background**

Within TemplaCMS, it is possible to define the frequency and length of breaks to be taken during a duty.

In the UK, the break pattern is only defined if breaks are unpaid, and the site is linked to a T&A system. They can be defined on the site record, with an optional override on an employee assignment to the contract. For example:




In Australia and Iceland (running the Awards Interpretation module), the pattern is defined within the award scheme to which each employee belongs, and the payable nature of the breaks can be varied by the shifts that the duty identifies as. For example:



## **Timegate+ Duty Export**

The export of duties to Timegate+ has now been enhanced to apply the appropriate pattern to each duty as it is built, determining whether each break is paid or unpaid as appropriate. The resulting details are then visible within Timegate+ Web and will shortly also be visible on Timegate+ Mobile.
